### A Jubilee Year

On Christmas Eve the Holy Father inaugurated a Jubilee Year. The tradition of Jubilee Year comes from the Old Testament when Jewish faithful were able to obtain some kind forgiveness, spiritual or material. Catholic Church is continuing this spiritual tradition on spiritual level. During a Jubilee Year each faithful could obtain a plenary indulgence under certain conditions. One of these conditions is a pilgrimage or visitation of the jubilee church and passing through the Holy Doors. Generally speaking, these special churches are major churches in the World and local cathedrals. All conditions to obtain a plenary indulgence you may find in the attachment to your emails for those who wished to receive them. On diocesan levels it will be inaugurated on Sunday 29th December in all cathedrals in the World. In Aberdeen Bishop Hugh will preside the Eucharist in St Mary's Cathedral at 11 am. It will be also a solemn Mass on this day in Oban at 10.30 am celebrated by Bishop Brian.
