The Solemnity of All Saints is transferred this year to Sunday November 2nd. The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls) is transferred this year to Monday November 3rd. There will be a Mass on this day, 3rd November, only in Kingussie at 6 pm.

November is the Month of the Holy Souls. It is good to remember in our prayers the souls of the departed loved ones. It is customary in our churches to display names of our departed loved ones on the altar at each Mass in November. It is possible to add your departed loved ones to the list. If you would wish that a priest will say a Holy Mass for the intention of your departed loved ones, please contact the priest. In November, after every weekday Mass we will say a decade of the Rosary for our departed loved ones and for the souls in purgatory.
