Blessing and Unveiling of the Portrait of Saint Maximilian Maria Kolbe

Everyone is warmly invited to the blessing and unveiling of the new portrait of **Saint Maximilian Maria Kolbe**, patron of the new Polish School in Aviemore. Saint Maximilian Maria Kolbe was a Polish Franciscan friar, priest, and missionary, known as a “*martyr of charity*” for offering his life in place of a fellow prisoner at Auschwitz during the Second World War. He was canonised by Pope John Paul II in 1982. The blessing will take place in the church on **Sunday, 18 January**, immediately after Holy Mass, and will be celebrated by Fr Andrew Harden.
